PRINCE2™ Method

PRINCE2™ is a process-based approach for project management, providing an easily tailored and scalable project management methodology for the management of all types of projects. The method is the de-facto standard for project management in the UK and is extensively practiced in more than 150 countries around the world. The number of people taking PRINCE2™ qualifications increases around 20% year on year, and it remains a key contributor to the successful delivery of projects.

PRINCE2™ Practitioner

The Practitioner is the second of two PRINCE2™ examinations that one is required to pass to become a Registered PRINCE2™ Practitioner. This examination measures whether a candidate would be able to apply PRINCE2™ to the running and managing of a project within an environment supporting PRINCE2™. A PRINCE2™ Practitioner qualification is a great asset for your resume and will give you the skills to feel confident in managing projects successfully within the workforce.

Examination

This course will take delegates to Practitioner level and provide the opportunity to sit the PRINCE2™ Practitioner Exam accredited by the Association for Project Management Group Ltd (APMG) in the UK.

- A scenario based objective testing exam PRINCE2™
- 9 complex multiple-choice questions
- 40 marks available per question
- 2.5 hours duration
- The pass mark is 55%
